

Expected Admission Guideline for the 2021-2022 Academic year

WHY AUT ?

Introduction of AUT

* AUT was established to nurture highly qualified personnel in accordance with the prospects for socio-economic development of Uzbekistan by the agreement on the Management of Ajou University's Academic Curriculum between the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education, Republic of Uzbekistan and Ajou University, Republic of Korea, based on the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PP.4041, November 30th, 2018. All departments of AUT provide 4-year daytime undergraduate courses, which are taught exclusively in English. Ajou University, established in 1973 under the motto of "Asia's Best University for the 21st century", is a leading research university with 11 colleges in Korea. Located in Suwon, about 30 km south of Seoul, Ajou has 14,000 students (9,700 undergraduates, 3,700 graduates, and 500 in other courses). The strength in Ajou's academic programs and research lies in Engineering, IT, Biotech, Nanotechnology, Medical Science, and Business and International Studies. Ajou is widely recognized for its innovative international programs and strong support for international students and has collaborative partnerships with over 322 universities in 65 countries. There are a wide range of international programs at Ajou, including student and faculty exchanges, international summer school, and Korean language programs. International students take courses offered in English in many majors. Today Ajou welcomes about 750 international students each year.



* Three reasons why you should choose AUT

1) **One Of The Best Education Systems:** Transference of the Excellent Education System of Ajou University in Korea

2) **Best Government Subsidy:** Citizens of Uzbekistan will pay tuition at rates charged by other universities in the country, with the cost differential supported by government subsidy. All domestic students admitted will be eligible for government subsidy during the 2021-2022 academic year and throughout their time at AUT, as long as they maintain good academic standing and their studies are not already supported by outside organizations. Government subsidy recipients commit to work 3 years for governmental organizations upon graduation.

3) **Best Job Opportunities:** Education in these key areas are necessary for Uzbekistan's economic growth. Also, AUT is actively cooperating with companies like Artel which is a leader of the electronical companies in Central Asia.

2. Application Procedure

Online Application -> Payment of Application Fee -> Orientation -> Entrance Examination -> Announcement of Successful Candidates -> Payment -> Submission of Original Documents -> Commencement



3. Eligibility for the 2021-2022 Admission

- Domestic or foreign lyceum, college or high school graduates or graduates-to-be in the first half of the year 2021.
- Applicants who passed the English Proficiency Requirements.
 - * Domestic Students
 - Minimum Requirement for Official English Test Score:
IELTS 5.0 or higher/TOEFL IBT 50 or higher and other certificates which can be equated with IELTS 5.0 or higher
 - Award Certificate of Uzbekistan English Olympiad
 - **English proficiency requirements are not essential and can be replaced by the AUT entrance exam.**
 - * International Students
 - Minimum Requirement for Official English Test Score:
IELTS 5.0 or higher/TOEFL IBT 50 or higher and other certificates which can be equated with IELTS 5.0 or higher
 - Among foreigner screening applicants, students with nationality of a country that uses English as their mother tongue or legal official language can be admitted without English Proficiency Requirements if they submit proof of completion of secondary or higher education (such as graduation certificate).
- Applicants who have South Korean Citizenship cannot apply for AUT admission by South Korean law.

* All AUT departments provide 4-year daytime undergraduate courses, which are taught in English.

* Depending on the applicant's test score, the admission quota may not be filled in the 1st exam.

* 1st preliminary successful candidates are automatically included in the second applicants. They compete with the second applicants for their first test scores.

* Up to 3 students from the Pre-University can be selected based on their graduation grades.

● All domestic and international students (foreign passport holders) must visit the online application site (admission.ajou.uz) to complete the AUT admission application and upload all required documents listed above.

● All scanned documents required for the admission decision should be submitted and uploaded through the AUT online application site(admission.ajou.uz) by the deadline. (acceptable file formats: JPEG, PNG, PDF). Email submissions cannot be accepted.

● ANY forged documents will result in a criminal complaint against the applicant.

● After the announcement of successful candidates, applicants must submit original documents by the application deadline.

7. AUT Entrance Exam for the 2021-2022 Admission

A. AUT Entrance Examination (Domestic Students)

- For the exams, OMR(Optical Mark Recognition) cards will be used for marking answers.
- Type of Examination: Written test
- All Subjects of Examination will be provided in English.
- Examination Subjects
 - Architecture/Civil Systems Engineering/Electrical and Computer Engineering.
 - English and Mathematics
 - Scoring and Timing may change.
 - Each department's exam questions will be different.
 - There is no penalty point to the incorrect answers on the exams.

B. International Student Special Admission

- All required documents listed in Section 6 should be uploaded onto the online application site(admission.ajou.uz) by the application deadline.
- The decision on international admission will be made upon completion of a comprehensive review of the documents submitted and online interview.
- Successful candidates must complete their registration by the registration deadline; qualification after the deadline cannot be accepted.

8. Application Fee

Applicants only who have Uzbekistan citizenship will have to pay an entrance application fee for passing internal exams in the amount of one minimum basic amount (approx. 245,000 sum) in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan. International applicants are free from application fee.
